Would you like to have prayers said for someone? There are several ways at St. Kateri to have that done.

1. **St. Kateri Prayer Chain**—a group of people from the parish who have committed to praying for others. That person will have prayers said for them every day for a week, then they will be added to the general prayers on the prayer chain. We do not share the information we receive
2. You can have someone's name added to the bulletin for prayers from our community.
3. Our parish has a "Hear Our Prayer" book in the entrance hall for people to write prayer requests. These are prayed for at mass during the Prayers of the Faithful.
4. Have a mass said for someone (usually one who is deceased). Just contact Claudia in the office for any mass intention.
