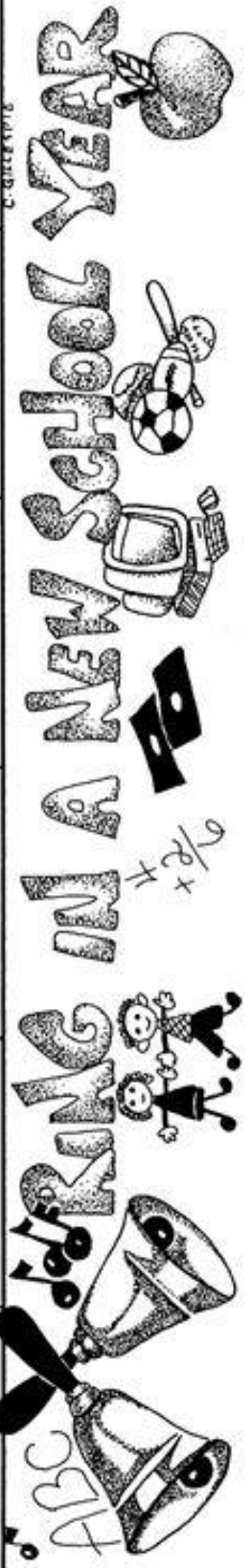

FALL SAFETY COURSES

Conducted by Tri-State Training & Safety Consulting, LLC

AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION BLS FOR HEALTHCARE PROVIDERS: This 3-hour BLS Provider course covers core material such as adult and pediatric CPR, foreign-body airway obstruction and automated external defibrillation. This course is for healthcare providers who must have a credential (card) documenting successful completion of a Healthcare Provider CPR course. The AHA's new BLS Course has been updated to include science and education from the 2015 Guidelines Update for CPT and ECC. It teaches both single-rescuer and team basic life support skills for application in both pre-hospital and in-facility environments, with a focus on high-quality CPR and team dynamics. The course replaces the BLS for Healthcare Providers course. **Course is \$80 per person & will be held Sept. 22nd, Oct. 13th or Nov 10th from 9:00am to 12:00pm at the Ridley Community Center, 801 Morton Ave., Folsom, PA.**

TRI-STATE CPR/AED PROGRAM: This 2-hour, instructor-led course teaches critical skills needed to respond to and manage an emergency until emergency medical services arrives. Skills covered in this course include first aid, choking relief in children and infants, and what to do for sudden cardiac arrest in children and infants. This course teaches skills with the AHA's research-proven practice-while-watching technique, which allows instructors to observe the students, provide feedback, and guide the students' learning of skills. Each participant receives a 2-year certification. **Course is \$65 per person & will be held Sept. 22nd, Oct. 13th or Nov. 10th from 12:30pm to 2:30pm at the Ridley Community Center, 801 Morton Ave., Folsom, PA.**

SCRIP PROGRAM

To all Families and Staff:

Welcome back to an exciting school year to all. Our new location offers a wonderful and welcoming place for our children.

I want to take this opportunity to introduce you to an opportunity to earn money off your tuition payments through the OLF Scrip Program. We offer gift cards for sale to Acme, Giant, Shop Rite, Kohl's, Wawa, Target, Walmart, Cocco's, Roy Tweedy's, CVS and Guys Deli. Credits are earned from 1 to 6% according to the stores you use. Kohl's can also be used to pay your charge.

In addition to these stores, we also carry gift cards for other retail stores and restaurants such as Panera, Olive Garden, Longhorn, Ruby Tuesday, Amazon, Bath and Body Works, Bed Bath and Beyond and others that are included on the list attached with this communication. There is also the opportunity to order cards for many other retailers that I order as needed. The orders are filled weekly for a quick turnaround. Again credits vary according to the stores.

Families that use this program have been able to reduce their tuition costs by various amounts from \$50 up to \$1000 according to how they take advantage of this program. I collect the tuition credit slips that we provide you at purchase, four times a year and turn them in to the tuition office to be credited to your Smart Account. There is no minimum or maximum that you are required to buy.

Scrip is sold in our rectory on Tuesday evening 6:30 to 8:00 PM, Saturday mornings from 8:30 to 9:30. I also give you the opportunity to send your order to school on Tuesday with your student and they are returned to you on Wednesday with your student.

If you are a member of a Parish that offers this program, please help your parish. However, you can take advantage of our program. It is offered to all students. We also provide tuition credits to Catholic High Schools and Catholic Colleges. Maximize your credits by asking family and friends to join you in this program. I have grandparents, aunts and uncles and friends purchasing to help our families. This is a perfect opportunity to start Christmas shopping.
