We will be collecting as much information about the gown itself, the couple who got married, etc. and will read the information as the gown is being modeled.

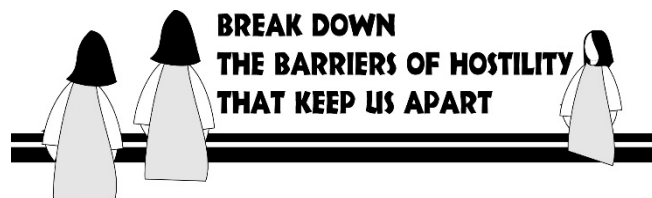
Wedding cake and coffee will be served after.

Word among Us Bible Study for Young Adults!

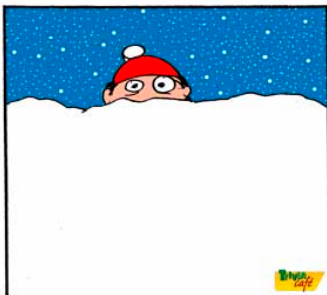
