(Inclement Weather Date – March 29)

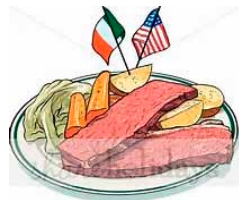

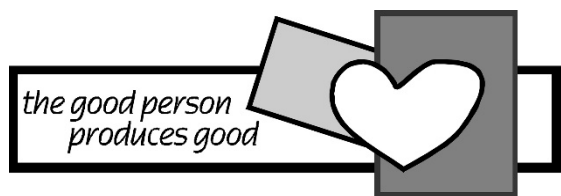
Vocation Discernment Weekend for Women
