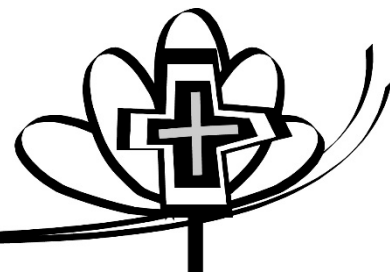
ESL (English as a Second Language) Classes

Announced Masses

There is perhaps no greater gift to offer a loved one than to have him/her remembered at Mass. In addition to arranging for a Mass you can request a card that you can give to the family of the person for whom you are arranging the Mass. A Mass can be offered for a variety of reasons. Most commonly these Masses are offered for someone who is deceased. Masses can also be said for the living (perhaps someone in need of healing) or for other special intentions. Two intentions can be offered for each Mass. The suggested donation for each intention is \$15.00 or \$30.00 if you would like two separate intentions for that Mass. You can arrange for a Mass and request a card online by calling or visiting our parish office. Please note, that your request for a Mass intention will be processed within 24 hours Monday through Friday. Requests received over the weekend (after 4 pm on Friday) will be processed on the following Monday. Your Mass intention and the date you requested is considered "confirmed" once you receive an email response back from our parish office.

Perpetual Masses

These Mass intentions are for souls to be enrolled in our Holy Souls Society. Those enrolled in the Holy Souls Society are prayed for once every week during the 9 am Mass. You will receive a Mass card that you can give to the family of the person for whom you are arranging the Mass.

Employer Matching Gifts Programs

Your employer might match dollar for dollar, in your financial support of our Parish and its Religious Education Programs. Check your employer's web site for "Matching Gifts". Your employer's Human Resources Department can provide you with additional information about the procedures involved.

Sacrament of Marriage

We invite and encourage couples who are planning marriage to speak with one of the priests or deacons. It is the policy of Sacred Heart Parish that the couples begin marriage preparation at least six months prior to the planned date. Fr. Byrnes must approve any departures from the policy. This is in order to allow time for the necessary paperwork, meetings with the priest or deacon as well as for the Pre-Cana program. The date at the Church is the first priority. Sometimes parishioners are surprised to find that the date and time they want is not available.

Anointing of the Sick/Hospital Visits

The confidentiality laws that affect the ministry of the Church have changed. You are asked on an admission form what religion you are. Naturally responding "Roman Catholic" you expect that a Catholic Chaplain will come by to see you. This is particularly important if you are going to be there over a weekend when Eucharistic Ministers can bring you Holy Communion. Be prepared to let them know that you would like to pray with them and receive Holy Communion unless you need confession.

The Admissions Office will no longer provide a list for local clergy according to the new Hippa laws, other than a generic list of Roman Catholic patients in the entire hospital. This is helpful for the chaplains who visit with each Catholic patient. If you want to see a priest during a hospital stay at Orange Regional Medical Center, a Chaplain is available. If you would like one of Sacred Heart's priests to visit the hospital, you need to call the parish office and give the name, room number, bed and phone number of the person you would like us to visit. If you would like to receive the Sacrament of the Sick, we would be happy to anoint you.
