


### ESL (English as a Second Language) Classes

The Servants of the Plan of God needs your help! We are a religious community founded in 1998 in Peru. By God's grace, today we are about 175 sisters from different countries and currently have 56 sisters living in our Formation Center, where they receive their primary education. We have been working diligently on getting the resources to support our Formation Center, but it has been difficult. We don't have sufficient incomes, so we depend on the charity of people to continue with our mission. **Our Father's Kitchen:** serves and delivers a hot, nutritious meal to those in need every Wednesday evening. Help is needed for clean up, mopping and serving.

**Our Mother's Cupboard:** provides diapers, wipes, formula and baby food to those in need. Donations of diapers sizes 4, 5, and 6 are always needed.

**OFK Food Pantry:** Provides meat, fresh produce, eggs, milk, canned goods and non-perishables to those in need every Wed morning. Help is needed unloading the truck and helping sort food every Wed morning 8:45-10:00am.

**The SonShine Boutique:** is a Thrift shop that offers clothing and household items very reasonably priced to those in need. Help is needed unloading the storage shed, sorting and folding clothes, setting up and taking down every Thursday morning 9-11:30 and 1:45-2:45pm.

**The St. Terese Furniture Program** picks up and delivers furniture to those in need. Help is needed driving the truck picking up from donor's driveways/garage and delivering to the donee's driveway. We do not enter homes.
