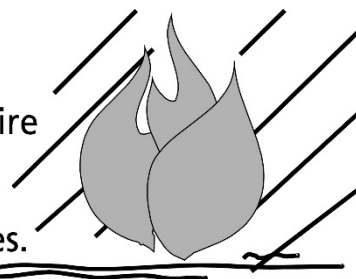
ESL (English as a Second Language) Classes

Diapers Needed!!!!

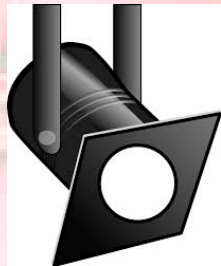
