

Hello Catechists!

We are very excited about the opening of the in-class sessions of SAL RE.

Here are a few reminders:

- * It is a good idea to send an email to the parents and ask that they send the silver folders back in with the students. These can be used for additional at homework in the future.
- * Please be in your classrooms 15 minutes ahead of time to set up. We will ask the students to line up outside your door with spacing. They can come in when you open your door.
- * I will place name card materials in your drawers for name tents. If you choose not to use them, just give them to the principal and they will get them back to me.
- * Mark your attendance on the white sheets and place outside your door on the clip. They will be returned to your drawer by next class.
- * Your lessons are in the file drawers with the class times on it. There is a pencil case with white board markers and an eraser in the top drawer for you to share with other classes.
- * There are also music and spoken CD's in the top drawers by grade, feel free to use them in class. (let me know if they are missing or the player does not work.
- * Classes are 50 minutes. You should have more than enough content to cover so pace yourself.
- * Be sure to introduce yourselves to the principals. They can help you monitor bathroom breaks, misbehaving children etc.
