One of the central meanings of Eucharist comes from what Jesus did at the first Eucharist, namely getting on His knees to wash the feet of others.

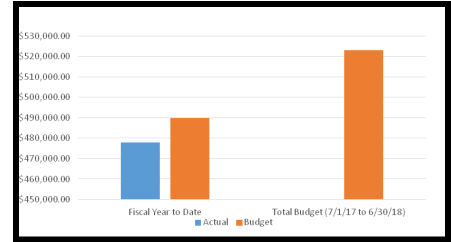

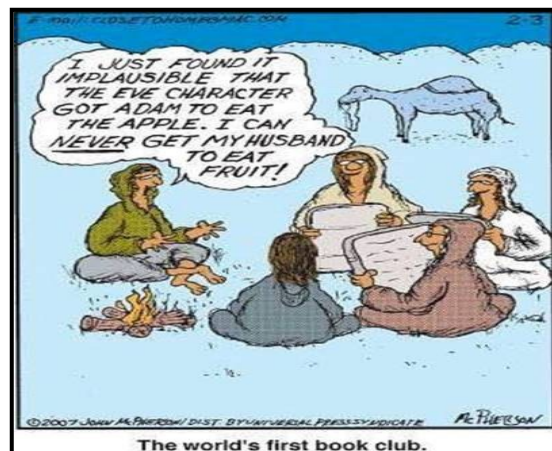

### MSOS Showcase is a Success!

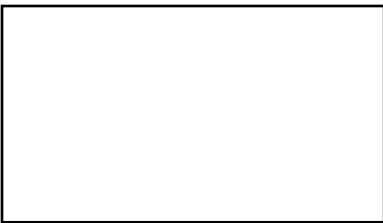

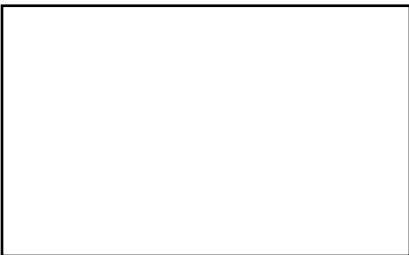

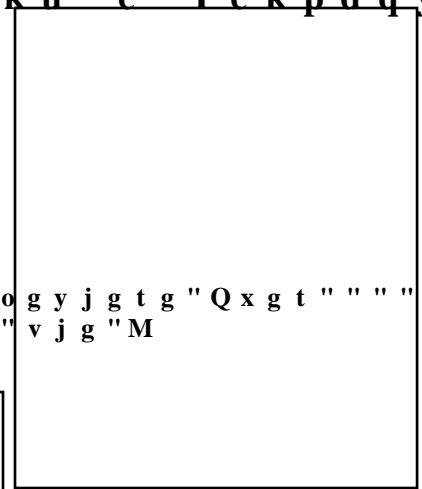
