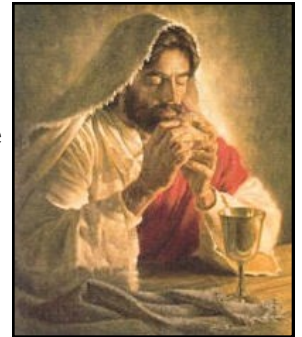

Youth Ministry has begun a new 2018-2019 year: Join our Middle School and High School Ministries today!

EDGE youth ministry (Grades 6-8) is a safe and fun place for youth to find solid catholic community, get answers to their questions about faith, and experience Jesus in a profound and personal way. EDGE resources speak to the physical, psychological, cognitive, relational, and spiritual maturation of middle school youth. EDGE meets twice a month, on the 2nd and 4th Friday from 6-8:30 PM in the 2nd Floor Activity Center.

LifeTeen youth ministry (Grades 9-12) is a Catholic youth ministry organization and movement that believe that Eucharist based ministry has the power to transform teens, parishes, and culture. LifeTeen meets twice a month, on the 1st and 3rd Friday from 6-8:30 PM in the 2nd Floor Activity Center.

Both EDGE and LifeTeen are also involved in the life of our parish by assisting with our different parish events and activities (i.e. Stations of the Cross) as well as participating in our year-round service projects (i.e. Food4Kids backpack program). Through these activities, our youth have the opportunity to develop their leadership skills and potential, which are critical as they journey through their teen years.

All youth grades 6-12 who will be preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation June, 2019 must be enrolled in EDGE or LifeTeen.
