I pray that all of us here in our Parish, through the purifying fire of the Holy Spirit, may be one with the whole Church to support the survivors of this crime committed by bishops, priests, and religious, or the victims in our families and neighborhoods perpetrated by family members, relatives or friends. Let us also pray for the abusers and for their total conversion. I encourage everyone to offer prayer and fasting, rosary and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament for healing, reconciliation and purification.

On a more pleasant issue, every month, beginning September, we will have a second collection to assist our two schools. Catholic education is at the heart of our mission as a Church. Through Mary, Star of the Sea School and ELC, we are fulfilling the work of evangelization entrusted to us by the Lord. 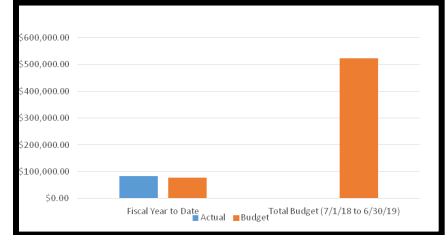
