Sacrament Class 2019 Update

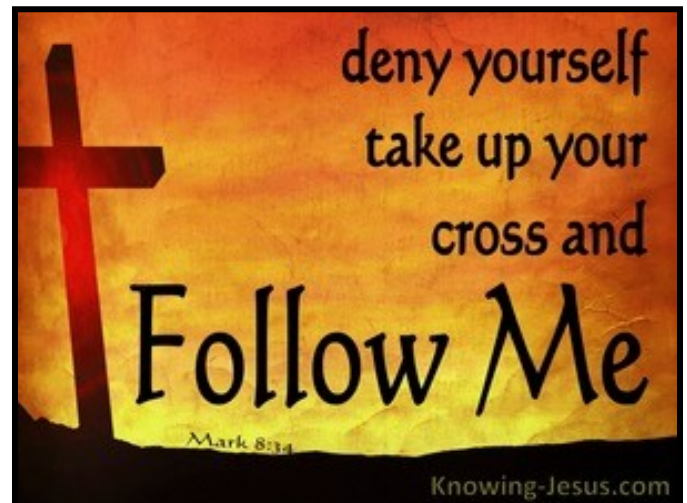
MSOS will begin offering the Sacrament of Confirmation to all children above the age of reason (7 years) in the Spring of 2019. Mary, Star of the Sea Parish is preparing for this restoration of the proper order of the Sacraments: Baptism, Confirmation, and First Holy Communion. Our Parish has prepared especially by developing a youth ministry for grades 6-8, Edge Youth Program and grades 9-12, LifeTeen Youth Program.

On June 9, 2019 seven year-olds who were baptized as infants will complete their sacraments of initiation in this order. They will be confirmed at their First Communion Mass at 8:15 am. As part of their preparation grade two children will receive the required sacrament of Reconciliation on Friday, December 7, 2018.

Gospel reading: Mark 8:27-35

- 34 He summoned the crowd with his disciples and said to them, "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me. 35 For whoever wishes to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for my sake and that of the gospel will save it.
- In v.34, Jesus faces other people (crowd) with the disciples, to address about discipleship.
- In .35, Jesus indicates the importance of following him and the gospel, over self-preservation.

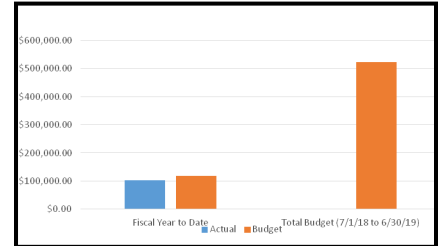
