Following Jesus means learning to listen to Him as God told the apostles when they were in the cloud. It is only possible to listen to God if we give God time. Listening in prayer starts with giving God attention, which is much more difficult than giving attention to what is visible before you. Learning to listen to God involves finding a way that you can best keep your attention focused on the God you cannot see.
