Lent is a wonderful time to celebrate the reconciling love and the healing graces our Lord offers us. Reconciliation is what God does.

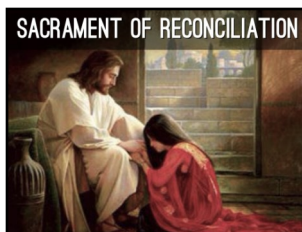
