Thank you for your donation to assist with the upkeep and maintenance of the church and/or cemetery grounds at Holy Angels Merged Worship Site.

All donations for the maintenance of the Holy Angels Merged Worship Site need to be mailed to St. Augustine Parish either at PO Box 13, Halbur, Iowa 51444-0013 or to St. Augustine Parish, % St. Bernard Parish Office, PO Box 39, Breda, Iowa 51436-0039. And checks need to be made out to St. Augustine Parish with the memo: "Holy Angels MWS Fund". The reason for this is explained below.

On 30 June 2018 the Parish of Holy Angels in Roselle closed and its assets [property and parishioners] were merged with the Parish of St. Augustine in Halbur. Thus, as of 1 July 2018, it has become the responsibility of the parish of St. Augustine to manage and care for the Holy Angels Merged Worship Site at Roselle which includes the church building and cemetery.

All donations we have received since July 8, after the final Mass on July 7, have been properly accounted, recorded, and deposited into bank accounts belonging to St. Augustine Parish in Halbur for the care and upkeep of Holy Angels MWS. Since 1 July 2018, all bank accounts of the former Parish of Holy Angels have been closed and all funds transferred into bank accounts belonging to St. Augustine Parish in Halbur for the care and upkeep of Holy Angels MWS. Money in these accounts will NOT be used for the care and upkeep of the church and cemetery Halbur. In addition, two former members of the Holy Angels Finance Council, Russ Riesenber and Tom Simons, have been added as members of the St. Augustine Finance Council.

Since July 1 we have been having difficulty with our bank allowing us to deposit checks made out to Holy Angels into the St. Augustine accounts for use for the care and upkeep of Holy Angels MWS for two reasons:

1. The Parish of Holy Angels is closed and no longer exists. Thus, we can no longer use the Federal ID number for Holy Angels.
2. Banking regulations do not allow for the deposit of checks written to one entity into the account of another entity.

We appreciate your support for the upkeep and care of the Holy Angels Merged Worship Site and ask for your support at the same time for St. Augustine Parish in Halbur or, if not a member at St. Augustine, support for your own parish so we may continue to provide the ministry needed for our Church.
