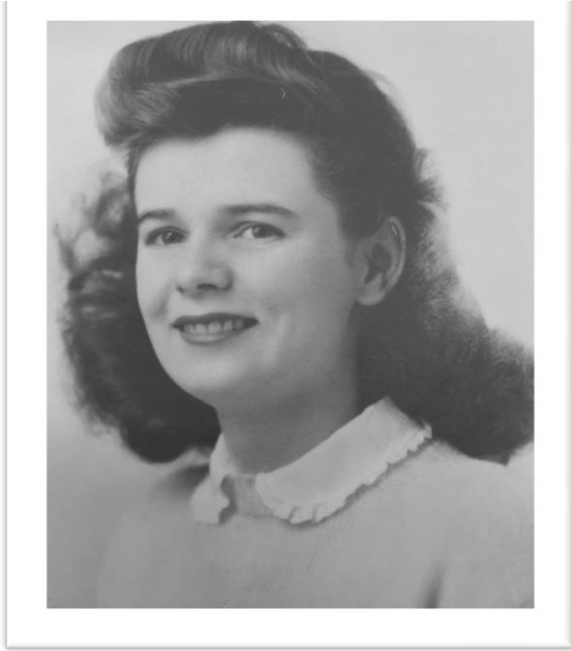


Donna Dolores Ogrinc
