The Property and Grounds Committee has concerns about the Pecan tree on the Southeast corner of the church near the garage. The leaves fall into the gutters of the church and the garage requiring them to be cleaned at least annually. Each year when the nuts fall the driveway, sidewalk, stairway and handicap ramp are covered with them and they must be cleaned up several times. These nuts create a hazard for the handicapped or for that matter anyone walking through this area to enter the church. There is concern someone may be injured by slipping and falling when the area is covered with nuts. Also as the tree has increased in size it now conflicts with the overhead power lines. It is realized there may be some sentimental feelings towards the tree. However it is felt the extra maintenance cost and the hazard created by the nuts and power lines warrant the removal of the tree.
