### **Planned Giving Brief: CARES Act**

This recently passed Congressional law includes a new deduction for charitable donors who do not itemize when filing their tax returns. You will be allowed to take a special tax deduction, up to \$300, to reduce your tax liability. It also includes an increase in a tax deduction limit up to 100% of a donor's annual in-come for cash gifts. Make a gift to the parish this year and deduct more when you prepare your 2020 tax return.
