Necessary social distancing steps to protect public health imposed by the states that restrict public gatherings for worship, while secular businesses such as liquor stores are deemed "essential", have challenged people of religious conviction who stay home to protect the health of others yet must guard against letting this crisis set lasting precedents that erode First Amendment protections for religious minorities.
