### **Day of Fasting and Prayer for Racial Healing**

As members of the Mystical Body of Christ we proclaim the power of prayer and fasting to transform our world and cast out the demonic influences that divide our communities and destroy its peace. As our country continues to contend with the historically traumatic issue of racism, we realize along with our bishops the need to beg God to heal our deeply broken view of each other, as well as our deeply broken society. Therefore, Archbishop Naumann invites and encourages all Catholics in the archdiocese to join him for a day of prayer and fasting on Wednesday September 9, the memorial of St. Peter Claver, to bring about racial healing in our communities. We fast to atone for the sins of racism and we pray for the healing of racial divisions in our nation. We look to St. Peter Claver, a 17<sup>th</sup> century Spanish Jesuit priest, for his intercession in our prayers. He is the patron saint of slaves and the ministry to African Americans.
