Voter Registration for the 2020 Election

Election Day is Tuesday, November 3. In order to be able to vote, you must be registered. The deadline to register to vote is Tuesday, October 13. You can register at www.kdor.ks.gov/Apps/VoterReg. It is important to register especially if you recently turned 18, recently moved or had a name change, have not voted in recent elections, or if you are unsure if you have registered. As Catholics, we are called not simply to vote, but to be well informed voters who in casting our ballots apply the moral principles and priorities of our Faith. The Catholic Church does not tell its members how to vote. At the same time, it is the responsibility of the Church to help form the consciences of her members to understand the principles and priorities that should guide their decisions as voters. Kansas Is No Longer Pro-Life

It's almost too difficult to hear, yet true. Literally overnight, "prolife" Kansas became one of the most radical pro-abortion states in the country when the Kansas Supreme Court recently created a nearly unlimited "right" to abortion in the case *Hodes & Hauser vs. Schmidt*. The #1 legislative priority of the Catholic Bishops of Kansas is VALUE THEM BOTH. What is VALUE THEM BOTH? The amendment is crucial because the Kansas Supreme Court recently created a nearly unlimited "right" to abortion, including taxpayer-funded abortion, teens seeking an abortion without parental knowledge or consent, and late term abortions. Once passed, VALUE THEM BOTH will help protect mothers and their unborn babies from the abortion industry. And it places the power to regulate the abortion industry back in the people's hands where it belongs. Become informed about this and other critical issues before casting your vote this November.
