**Kansas Is No Longer Pro-Life**

It's almost too difficult to hear, yet true. Literally overnight, "prolife" Kansas became one of the most radical pro-abortion states in the country when the Kansas Supreme Court recently created a nearly unlimited "right" to abortion in the case *Hodes & Hauser vs. Schmidt*. Once passed, VALUE THEM BOTH will help protect mothers and their unborn babies from the abortion industry. And it places the power to regulate the abortion industry back in the people's hands where it belongs.
