### **Archbishop Naumann Lenten Reflection**

As the season of Lent nears the end, it is good to remember that there is still time. Whether you have not had a chance to spend time reflecting on this journey, or you are still going strong since Ash Wednesday, or you are somewhere in between; Holy Week is a great time to focus on the sacrifices of Christ and how we can imitate that in our lives. Archbishop Naumann has been offering Lenten reflections each week beginning with Ash Wednesday. Each day of Holy Week, you can take a look back on the Lenten journey and walk with the Archbishop as he reflects on Lent. The 30-minute audio sessions include the Archbishop's reflection on the Gospel (Ash Wednesday/Sunday) and a short personal witness from a member of the Archdiocese. The last reflection focuses on Christ's life during Holy Week.
