Divine Mercy Sunday Plenary Indulgence

1. Receive the **sacrament of confession** in the 8 days leading up to the Sunday,
2. receive **Holy Communion** on that day,
3. and recite **prayers for the intentions of the Holy Father** (1 Our Father and 1 Hail Mary is the minimum, but any other additional prayers may be added).
4. **Visit a church and** in a spirit completely detached from the affection for a sin, even a venial sin, devoutly recite the Divine Mercy chaplet OR recite the Our Father and the Creed, adding a devout prayer to the merciful Lord Jesus, e.g. "Merciful Jesus, I trust in you!"

"I Will Give Half" Campaign to Support Pro-Life Causes

For almost 50 years, there has been bipartisan agreement not to fund abortion with taxes. Sadly, the recent passage of the 2021 American Rescue Plan Act ended that stretch. Previous COVID relief legislation had prohibited abortion funding. Bishop Peter Christiansen of the Diocese of Boise, Idaho devised a response to this distressing development called "I Will Give Half." Archbishop Naumann is also promoting this initiative which encourages those who can afford to do so, to give at least half (\$700) of their Covid relief assistance to a pro-life organization, specifically a local pregnancy resource center or to the efforts for the passage of the "Value Them Both" state constitutional amendment in August 2022.
