Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings for the Thirty-Second Sunday in Ordinary Time present one of the foundational teachings of our Christian faith: the resurrection from the dead. The first reading from the Second Book of Maccabees offers some of the earliest witness to the Jewish belief in the resurrection from the dead and captures in broad strokes the Jewish theology of resurrection at that time.

The second reading is taken from Paul's Second Letter to the Thessalonians. In today's reading, Paul continues to encourage the Thessalonian Christians "the Lord is faithful; he will strengthen you and guard you from the evil one."

Today's Gospel reading presents an early encounter between Jesus and "some Sadducees," Jewish religious leaders in Jerusalem, intent on trapping Jesus in a public debate. Luke characterizes the Sadducees as "those who deny that there is a resurrection." Their questioning of Jesus about Mosaic marriage laws and resurrection is clearly insincere, intending to embarrass Jesus and show the folly of the belief in the resurrection from the dead in front of the crowds. Jesus ended his response with the declaration that God "is not God of the dead, but of the living, for to him all are alive." The Sadducees were actually impressed with Jesus' response, stating, "Teacher, you have answered well."
