Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe

The solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ the King is the last Sunday in ordinary time and brings the church year to a close. The first reading recounts the anointing of David as King of Israel, the greatest king to rule over the United Monarchy. Despite his military and political genius, David also exercised poor judgment, committing the grave sins of adultery and murder, which caused him to repent and experience deep remorse for his sin. Through all of this, God recognized that David was a man after God's own heart, and established an everlasting covenant with David.

The second reading from Paul's Letter to the Colossians unpacks some of the mystery and majesty of Jesus as King and Lord of the universe. Paul tried to answer this question by inserting a hymn used by the early Christians that defined Jesus' true identity.

Today's Gospel reading is Luke's narration of the crucifixion of Jesus. As he suffered the agonizing pain of the cross, the religious rulers "sneered at Jesus," the soldiers "jeered at him," even one of the criminals crucified alongside of Jesus "reviled" him. With remarkable irony, these people mocked Jesus with the titles of Christ and King. In the mystery of salvation history, the suffering and death of Jesus fulfills the Davidic covenant and is fundamental to his everlasting reign as King and Lord of the universe.
