Pentecost

On Pentecost Sunday, we are reminded that the church is grounded in the risen Christ and guided by the Holy Spirit. In the first reading from the Acts of the Apostles, Luke tells us that “there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit.” This description of the descent of the Holy Spirit onto the apostles recalls the words of John the Baptist to the people he baptized, “I am baptizing you with water ... he will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire”. The symbol of fire was important to Luke in his discussion of the birth of the Church. Fire represented God’s transformative presence that purified and refined the apostles in preparation for the challenge of building the church.

In the second reading from Paul’s Letter to the Romans, we hear Paul speak of the dichotomy between the Spirit and the flesh.

In the Gospel reading from John’s farewell discourse, we hear Jesus speak of the descent of the Holy Spirit onto the disciples. Jesus assured the disciples: “I will ask the Father, and he will give you another Advocate to be with you always... The Advocate, the Holy Spirit whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you.”
