## Twenty Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings for the Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time continue the theme from last Sunday: divine judgment against those who are self-centered and self-indulgent at the expense of others. In the first reading, Amos speaks of the abuse and complacency of those in power toward the poor and marginalized of his day, which helped explain Israel's defeat and exile at the hands of the Assyrians. The ruling class shamelessly indulged in the luxuries of life while being completely oblivious to the impending threat about to consume them as a people. For this, Amos forewarned, God will hold them accountable.

In the second reading from Paul's First Letter to Timothy, Paul urges Timothy to pursue those virtues that promote the Christian faith, to seek eternal life, and to keep the commandments until the return of Christ.

In the Gospel reading, we hear Jesus' parable of the rich man and Lazarus, which He directs to the Pharisees. The rich man's self-centered perspective and desire to be separated from the unclean resembles much of what Jesus criticized with the Pharisees. The rich man's consistent concern only for himself and his own kinship group to the very end, never once expressing remorse or concern for the plight of the poor, accentuates his self-centered and blind perspective to what really matters to God.
