Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings for the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time speak to the unity that Christ brings to all people who believe in him and his words. In the first reading, the prophet Isaiah foretold that one day God would redeem (glorify) the northern kingdom; “upon those who dwelt in the land of gloom a light has shone.” The day was coming, according to Isaiah, when God would redeem the whole region, including the Gentiles.

In the second reading, we continue with Paul’s First Letter to the Corinthians. Paul is upset about the divisions that have occurred in the community in Corinth. Paul rightly attempts to create unity among the Corinthian Christians by having them focus on “the cross of Christ” as the source of their unity in the church.

In today’s Gospel, Matthew tells us that Jesus chose not to live in his hometown of Nazareth; rather, he “went to live in Capernaum by the sea.” Matthew provides no additional information, aside from its fulfillment of Isaiah’s prophecy (see the first reading). Matthew signals the “official” start of Jesus’ public ministry with the statement, “From that time on, Jesus began to preach and say, ‘Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand’.” The Gospel reading also includes Matthew’s version of the call of the first disciples.
