Third Sunday of Lent

As we continue on our Lenten journey, we can use the Samaritan woman as a role model for discipleship. We, too, are challenged to find the Lord in our midst and bring others to him. The first reading is taken from Exodus 17. Within a relatively short period of time following their miraculous escape from the Egyptian army, the Israelite community began quarreling among themselves and challenging Moses and his leadership. The Israelites even tested God, asking Moses: "Is the LORD in our midst or not?" Moses pleaded to God for intervention, and God responded by empowering Moses to use his staff to strike on the rock in Horeb, drawing water from the rock for the people to drink. The Lord was indeed in the midst of the community during the desert journey, but the Israelites' grumbling and complaining blinded them to the Lord's presence.

In the second reading from the Letter to the Romans, Paul teaches us that we have "peace with God" through our relationship with Christ and we have the "love of God" through the Holy Spirit. For Paul, it is in this divine relationship where "God proves his love for us."

In today's reading, Jesus meets a Samaritan woman at a well and initiates a dialogue with her with a simple request: "Give me a drink." This encounter between Jesus and the Samaritan woman falls into four parts: the Samaritan woman challenges Jesus; she recognizes Jesus as a prophet and Jesus reveals to the woman his messianic identity; the disciples return and the woman leaves to tell others of her belief in Jesus; and the Samaritans themselves recognize Jesus as "truly the savior of the world."

GUIDELINES IN LIGHT OF THE SPREAD OF THE CORONA VIRUS

With the introduction of the novel coronavirus (Covid-19) into the metropolitan area, it is advisable to take some sensible steps in regard to how we comport ourselves at mass in order to prevent clergy or members of the congregation from transmitting or acquiring the virus.

Attendance at Mass. If you are not feeling well and have flu-like symptoms, consider yourself free of the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. It might be more considerate of others not to come to church that Sunday.

The Sign of Peace. Instead of shaking hands with the person next to you, simply nod or wave or give an "elbow bump."

Holy Communion. The ministers of the Eucharist should cleanse their hands with sanitizer before and after they distribute the sacred hosts. It is suggested that in receiving Holy Communion, you would do so in the hand, rather than on the tongue. With the distribution of the Eucharist on the tongue, there is always the possibility of saliva coming onto the minister's fingers, which could then be passed onto the remaining hosts, possibly transmitting the virus to another congregant or to the minister of the Eucharist.

Out of concern for the health of the Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist, who graciously volunteer their service, if you should wish to receive the Eucharist on the tongue, we ask that you approach the priest.

Greeting after Mass. The celebrant will not be shaking hands with the members of the congregation as they leave mass.

Prayer. Let us pray for all those who are suffering throughout the world and for all medical personnel who are attending to their needs with such care and dedication.
