## September 13, 2020

### Twenty-Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

The scriptures today reflect the power that is found in the word "forgiveness". Every person has the power to forgive. In our world beset with hatred, war, and discrimination, rarely do we resort to the use of this power. We are set on dominating, getting even, putting others in their place. We judge, presume intentions and motivation, yet fail to see the failures in ourselves. The power to forgive is a gift we can choose to use, for our own well being and for others. In the first reading, Sirach advises all to forgive the faults of their neighbor. Only by forgiving the sins of others, can a person expect to be forgiven of his sins.

In the second reading, Paul stresses that no one is his own master; we are responsible to the Lord, and we belong to him in both life and death.

Today's Gospel reading points out the difference between mercy and justice. When Peter asks how often he should forgive someone, Jesus answers, "...not seven times: I say seventy times seven times." Jesus then narrates the parable of the *Unmerciful Servant* to teach two things: On the one hand, forgiveness is limitless. And on the other hand, forgiveness is an unbreakable whole; it is impossible to separate God's forgiveness from the forgiveness we show to one another.
