## September 20, 2020

### Twenty-Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's readings, which include one of Jesus' parables and a reading taken from Israel's prophetic tradition, we hear that God's plan is to save all people. In the first reading, the prophet Isaiah points out our limited ability to understand God's ways: "As high as the heavens are above the earth, so high are my ways above your ways and my thoughts above your thoughts."

The second reading, taken from Paul's Letter to the Philippians and composed while in prison in Rome in the year AD 60, is Paul's thanksgiving that opens his letter. In this section of the letter, he shares his own ambivalence about life and death and the end of his nearly thirty-year ministry.

In today's Gospel we hear Jesus tell the crowd the parable of the workers in the vineyard. In the parable, Jewish members of Matthew's community would have seen themselves as the workers hired by the landowner at dawn to work the vineyards. The resentment expressed by the workers hired at dawn (Jews) toward both the landowner (God) and the last-hour workers (Gentiles) probably mirrored the resentment felt by many members of the Jewish Christian members of Matthew's community.

The Religious Education Program at STM is a 2 year program in which your child will be preparing to receive his/her First Holy Communion or Confirmation. They will learn to build their Catholic identity around core Catholic beliefs, practices, and principles so that they can truly embody their faith.

- **Communion** classes for **first** year students will be held every Tuesday from 4-5pm via Zoom beginning Tues. Oct. 6<sup>th</sup>
- Returning (2<sup>nd</sup> yr) students for **First Communion** will continue their classes on Tuesdays from 5-6pm via Zoom beginning Tues. Oct. 6<sup>th</sup>
- **First year Confirmation** classes will be held in person from 5-6pm beginning Thurs. October 8<sup>th</sup>
- Returning (2<sup>nd</sup> yr) students for **Confirmation** will continue their classes in person on Thursdays from 6-7pm beginning October 8<sup>th</sup>

We will be following the COVID guidelines as classes commence. The classes will be held in the Rochester Room where each child will sit 6ft apart wearing masks.
