Third Sunday of Easter

The readings for the Third Sunday of Easter remind us of our duty as baptized Christians to bear witness to others of our faith in the resurrection of Jesus, who saves us from our sins. The first reading from Acts is a pointed speech, which Peter delivered, informing the people of Jerusalem how Jesus' suffering and death were foretold by the prophets. In this speech, he makes the case that the people's repentance for handing Jesus over to Pilate to be killed is both necessary for conversion and for the forgiveness of sins.

In the second reading from First John, the Apostle speaks of his motivation for writing this letter to his community: "My children, I am writing this to you so that you may not commit sin." The Apostle goes on to define sinners as those who claim to "know" Jesus "but do not keep his commandments."

In the Resurrection narrative of Luke's Gospel Jesus "opened their minds to understand the Scriptures" that foreshadowed his suffering, death, and resurrection. Luke concludes his Resurrection narrative by highlighting the disciples' role in preaching repentance and forgiveness of sins and by emphasizing the disciples as "witnesses of these things...to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem."
