Sixth Sunday of Easter

The theme of love permeates the readings for the Sixth Sunday of Easter. From Jesus' command to his disciples, to the Apostle's definition of the essence of God, love lies at the core of all that is divine. The first reading from Acts narrates an encounter between Peter and Cornelius, which leads Peter to the insight that he, a Jew, should no longer consider Gentiles as unclean people, and leads to Peter's proclamation at the beginning of today's reading: "In truth, I see that God shows no partiality. Rather, in every nation whoever fears him and acts uprightly is acceptable to him."

In the second reading from First John, the Apostle offers some simple advice to his community members: "Let us love one another, because love is of God."

Today's Gospel reading is a continuation of Jesus' vine-and-branches discourse and is part of Jesus' larger farewell discourse to the disciples. Jesus makes the point that the "branches" (the disciples) remain connected to the "vine" (Jesus) by keeping Jesus' commandments. And Jesus tells the disciples, "This is my commandment: love one another as I love you." Jesus then connects his impending cross to his love-commandment: "No one has greater love than this, to lay down one's life for one's friends."
