Seventh Sunday of Easter

In the Seventh Sunday of Easter, the disciples learn to discern the workings of the Holy Spirit, as their sure guide to the truth of the mission to which they were called. The first reading narrates the reconstitution of the Twelve Apostles. During their deliberation, Peter and the remaining Apostles turned to Scripture and prayed to the Holy Spirit for guidance and inspiration as they discerned between two worthy replacements.

In the second reading, John defines the essence of God in saying, "God is love." By defining God in these terms, God's love cannot be passively received; it requires us to love one another.

The Gospel reading is part of Jesus' concluding prayer of petition to his Father. In this final prayer, Jesus prays for both his current disciples as well as all future disciples. Jesus petitions his Father with three specific requests. First, Jesus prays, "Holy Father, keep them in your name" and invites his disciples to "remain" in the intimate relationship between Father and Son. Second, Jesus prays, "keep them from the evil one." Third, Jesus finally prays, "consecrate them in the truth." Jesus was sending the disciples "into the world" arming them with the truth as they begin their mission of evangelization.
