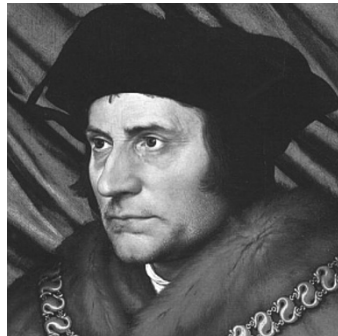

Twenty Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

The readings for today call us to rethink how we define and live out our faith in our daily lives. Is our faith simply a set of clearly defined rules to follow or is our faith lived out in a manner that truly embraces and applies God's sacred laws to our everyday lives?

Today's Gospel, an abbreviated version of Mark 7:1-23, details some of the objections raised by the critics of Jesus and his disciples. On its most basic level, the Pharisees and Scribes expressed public concern that Jesus' behavior violated the "tradition of the elders," especially some of the Jewish laws associated with purity rites and regulations. The example raised is Jesus and the disciples, after "coming from the marketplace," ate meals without washing (purifying) their hands; they ate food with "unclean hands." The mention of the "marketplace" is a reference to an area where Jews would encounter, and often interact with, Gentiles. Exposure to Gentiles, especially physical contact, would make Jews unclean. Many Jews, therefore, were very sensitive to the "marketplace." It is important to note that Jesus' response is directed to the crowds: "Hear me, all of you, and understand. Nothing that enters one from outside can defile that person; but the things that come out from within are what defile." Not only was Jesus publicly challenging the Jewish leaders' interpretation of the Mosaic law, he was also, in effect, challenging the legitimacy of the separation between Jews and Gentiles.

Hutchinson was sent to the United States to serve in the Archdiocese of Dubuque, Iowa, as an Associate Pastor of the Church of Resurrection and as Pastor of Prince of Peace Cluster (St. Paul, Sacred Heart, and St. Mary of Mt. Carmel). Fr. Hutchinson said that moving from Iowa to New York is a big change, but the lovely people he has met makes the transition smooth and lovely. He also says that he is looking forward to serving God's people at OLGC & STM and to the opportunity to draw from the rich experiences of Fr. Madigan and the staff of OLGC & STM. In closing, Fr. Hutchinson asks each of us to pray for his success in this new mission.
