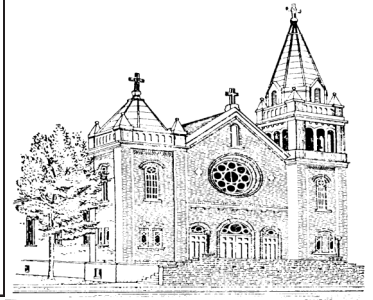

Do You Need Work Done At Your Home? Catholic Heart Workcamp Can Help!
Catholic Heart Workcamp, a week-long service camp for teenagers, will be coming to Saranac Lake this summer and is seeking homes in the Saranac Lake area (within 45 miles of Saranac Lake) at which a small group of teenagers and adults can work. Groups will be available to work on June 24-27, from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Our focus is on the elderly, disabled, and those unable to hire this work to be done. Those interested in having a CHWC team work at their home should contact the parish office to request an application.

The mission of Catholic Heart Workcamp is to share the love of Christ through service and to inspire participants to live as disciples of Christ. This year's camp has some 250 participants coming to Saranac Lake to serve the people of the North Country.
