

FROM THE PASTOR...

You may recall a few months ago we raised the question of the plan for Holy Name Church. Recall the survey with two plans: Plan A, Living Stones Plan and Plan B, Petition to Bishop LaValley.

The packet was sent to the Chancery....The response from the Chancery came late last week. After consultation with the Presbyteral Council, Bishop LaValley gives Holy Name Church in Tupper Lake the canonical status of Oratory.

Oratory status means:

- Baptisms may not be celebrated in an Oratory.
- Daily and Sunday Masses may not be celebrated in the Oratory.
- Reservation of the Blessed Sacrament is not allowed in the Oratory.
- Remove valuable articles and sacred vessels from the Oratory.

As time goes on we will learn more of the administration of our Oratory and the eventual sale. Nine churches were closed at the March Meeting of the Presbyteral Council
