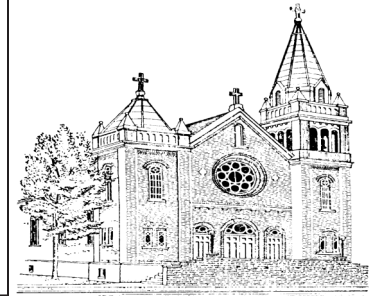

Did you know? ...

All Diocesan clergy and employees, all Catholic school and parish employees, and all volunteers whose duties require contact with minors must undergo a background check. The Diocese of Ogdensburg has conducted over 875 background checks since January 1, 2019. Background checks help keep predators away from children because they can uncover past actions which should ban an adult from working or volunteering with children.
