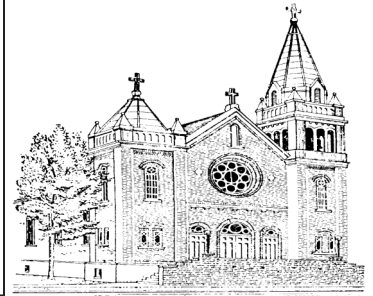

CATHOLIC HEART WORKCAMP RETURNS!

Catholic Heart Workcamp will be returning to Saranac Lake from June 22-25, 2020, so start planning now to have a team of teenagers help with projects at your home! Teams will travel to sites within a 35-mile radius of North Country Community College in Saranac Lake. Work order forms can be picked up at the parish office or by calling Jocelyn Kelly at 518-651-0786 or by emailing Jocelyn at

chwc.ogdensburg@gmail.com. Completed work order forms are due by May 31 and are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. They can be emailed to chwc.ogdensburg@gmail.com or mailed to: Jocelyn Kelly, St. Mary's Church, PO Box 499, Fort Covington, NY 12937. Even if you had a team help at your house last summer, you are still eligible to have assistance again this summer. Catholic Heart Workcamp teams can: paint homes (both interior and exterior), porches, garages and decks; clean homes; wash windows; do yardwork such as planting, weeding, raking and clearing brush; haul and stack firewood; clean out garages; and build and repair railings, porches and steps. Teams will be available Monday, June 22, through Thursday, June 25, from approximately 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Our focus is on the elderly, disabled and those unable to hire this work to be done, and there is no charge for the service. With approximately 250 teenagers from New Jersey, Wisconsin, Pennsylvania, Illinois and Michigan coming to Saranac Lake, there are plenty of work teams available to help individuals and agencies throughout the region. A week-long service camp for teenagers, CHWC's mission is to share the love of Christ through service and to inspire participants to live as disciples of Christ.
