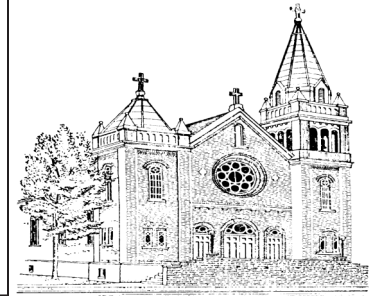

The coronavirus (COVID-19) has arrived in N.Y. State. Although health officials are saying that the risk of becoming infected is still relatively low, it is important that we take proper precautions to stay healthy! If you are over 60, have an underlying condition such as heart or respiratory disease, diabetes, or have a compromised immune system, you are considered to be at high risk for contracting this virus. Symptoms of this virus are fever, cough and shortness of breath and is spread by respiratory droplets. Here are some practical steps you can take to prepare for a potential outbreak in our area. Most of these steps are things we should be doing all the time!

- Wash your hands before cooking or eating, after bathroom use, after blowing your nose, or after being out in public places. Proper hand washing should be done with soap and running water for a full 20 seconds!! Use a hand sanitizer (60-70% alcohol) whenever soap and water are unavailable.
- If you are sick, stay at home, and stay away from sick people.
- Cough or sneeze into your elbow or a tissue (discard after use). Do not cough or sneeze into your hand!
- Don't touch your face. Eyes, nose, and mouth are portals of entry for bacteria and viruses into your body.
- Make sure you are stocked with enough medications, food, and disinfectants in case you and family members are quarantined in your home. So buy a few extra items for your pantry and freezer when you shop this week.

- Consider staying away from public events, particularly if you are in the high risk category.

Be mindful, be careful, and stay healthy!
