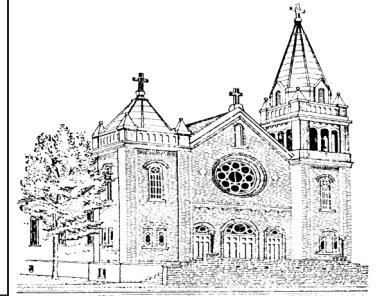

ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

Have you ever wished you knew of a natural weed killer that protected the soil and the water while keeping under control those plant species that grow where you don't want them (better known as "WEEDS")? Here is one to try: 4 cups white vinegar; 1/4 cup salt and 1 tsp. liquid soap. Combine ingredients in a spray bottle and spray the weeds at the sunniest time of the day for best results. Spray carefully. This stuff can't tell a flower or vegetable plant from a "weed!" This recipe and for many other recipes: search for "homemade weed killer."
