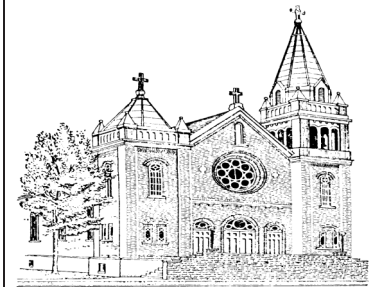

Fifth Sunday of the Lent
