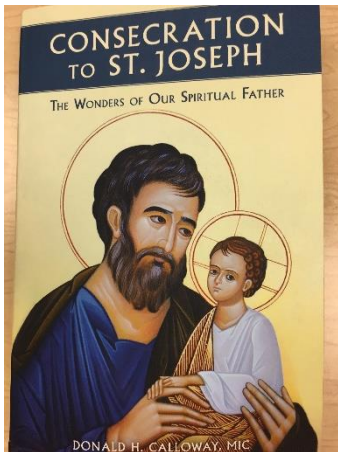


Father Jim Parker, Pastor of Holy Cross Church, Invites You to Participate in the

The **February 3rd meeting** is introductory and no reading is necessary before we meet. However, you might like to read the INTRODUCTION, pages 1-9. During the first meeting, the group will read Day 1 together.

Start the daily readings on Monday, February 10th, with Day 2.

For the **February 17th meeting**, you should complete the readings through Day 8.

For the **February 24th meeting**, you should complete the readings through Day 15.

For the **March 2nd meeting**, you should complete the readings through Day 22.

For the **March 16th meeting**, you should complete the readings through Day 33.

On **Thursday, March 19th**, Father Parker will celebrate **Mass at 5:30 PM** and we will make our **Consecration to St. Joseph**. The St. Joseph Table starts at **6:30 PM** in Donovan Hall for those who can attend.
