

Sample Progression of Terms in Religion COS 2015



Incarnation: This term is primarily dealt with in I. Knowledge of the Faith—A. Person of Jesus Christ

Grade 1:

I.A.1. Know Jesus is the Son of God and Son of Mary (CCC 495)

Grade 4:

I.A.2. Know that Jesus has a fully human nature which includes human emotions (CCC 470-478, Jn 11:33-38, Lk 4:2, Mt 21:12)

I.A.3. Know that Jesus has a fully divine nature. He was conceived in the womb of the Virgin Mary through the power of the Holy Spirit (CCC 464-469)

Grade 7:

I.A.1. Describe what it means to say that Jesus Christ is fully human and fully divine

Paschal Mystery: This term and its implications are largely addresses in II. Liturgical Life—A. Paschal Mystery Forms and Transforms

Grade 2:

II.A.1. Know the Liturgy is a participation in the life, death and resurrection of Jesus (CCC 571, 1068)

Grade 4:

II.A. 1 Know that God shows his love by sending Jesus to save us from sin and death through the Paschal Mystery (CCC 601, 654; 1Cor 15:14)

Grade 7:

II.A.2. Know that participation in the Eucharist is an actual participation in the crucifixion and resurrection of Christ (CCC 1068, 1088, 1090, 1104)

Sacrament: This term and its related information is found primarily in II. Liturgical Life—B. Sacraments

Grade 2:

II.B.1. Define a sacrament as an outward sign, instituted by Christ, to give grace (CCC 1131)

Grade 5:

II.B.1. Understand that sacraments are celebrated by and for the community not just the individual (CCC1140)

Grade 7:

II.B.3. Know that the sacraments are the action of the Church and an integral part of her public prayer (CCC1071, 1140)

Catholic Social Teaching: Is specifically addressed in IV. Missionary Spirit—C. Social Action and Transformation—but elements are found throughout the Community Life and Missionary Spirit tasks

Grade 1:

VI.C.1. Know that a Christian is called to help build the Kingdom of God (CCC 2046; Mt 6:33)

Grade 4:

VI.C.1. Define the virtue of justice as giving God and others what is due to them (CCC 1807)

Grade 7:

VI.C.2. Know that common good and human dignity are foundational principles for building a better world (CCC 1807, 1928-1933)
