Who is Eligible and Highlights

This Religious Emblem may be earned through the Catholic Committee on Scouting. Any BSA-registered male or female, ages 16 to 21, is eligible and 17-18 is most common. Any Catholic Venturer, male or female, is also eligible. The Ad Altare Dei Emblem is not a prerequisite, but if possible, participants should earn the AAD Emblem before earning the Pope Pius XII emblem.

We are all on a journey through time and space with many paths to choose. The burning questions remain on all our hearts: "Which paths remain? Which path to choose? On what path am I headed?" Consider this extended weekend excursion down the Muskingum River for meeting new friends, participating in discussion groups, exploring your vocation in life, while eating great food, Canoeing, and participating in reconciliation and Mass.

This program will be completed over the extended weekend, under the direction of a team of qualified counselors. A priest, married couple and young adults will facilitate this insightful and relaxing Canoeing and Camping weekend on scenic Muskingum River.
