## Gospel Road 2021

### What is Gospel Road 2021?

Gospel Road is a multi-day mission focused work camp for youth in grades 9-12 along with their adult chaperones and volunteers, at Catholic churches and schools throughout the Diocese of Columbus. Gospel Road is a parish driven and Diocesan supported event. It is designed to allow teens the opportunity to live the Gospel message of love while helping them learn practical skills working with caring adults who spend their time teaching, mentoring and growing in conjunction with them.

It will also be supported by special guest presenters at the end of each work day, which will be available on-line through a link to the Gospel Road program.

### When is Gospel Road 2021?

Gospel Road will be held in individual - participating parishes Sunday July 11 to Tues July 13, 2021.

### How many will participate?

Registration is limited to the mandates of each parish

### Who can attend?

Parishes or Catholic schools from throughout the Diocese of Columbus are welcome and encouraged to participate.

### How do we register?

All registration is done through your home youth group. ALL registrations should be done using the Diocesan approved forms that have been assigned for Gospel Road.

### What is the cost to participate?

It is the intentions of Gospel Road to keep the cost reasonable so that parishes/schools are able provide participation for as many youth as possible. Cost to participate will be \$40 per person, which include a Gospel Road T-shirt, and access to the Gospel Road special programs.

### What sort of projects will be undertaken?

Working with local agencies the local committee for Gospel Road will be searching for projects that help the youth to live the Gospel message of love and concern and complete work that is meaningful and helps make an impact on the lives of those being served. In cooperation with people serving agencies in the parish/school projects will be identified that help either the agency itself or individuals served by that particular agency. Projects could be as simple as weeding; to as complicated as building projects; or in between such as painting and cleaning. Projects assigned will be both age and ability appropriate to the work groups. All projects will be carefully considered so that the teens participating not only "get the job done" but leave having experienced what making a difference can truly mean within the surrounding communities.
