This calendar follows the *Order of Worship* as approved by the Congregation for Divine Worship on 22 June 1972 in Rome for the American Cassinese Congregation of Benedictine Monasteries.

**LECTIO DIVINA:** The following is the schema of readings for this month which we encourage you to consider as a prayerful preparation for the Sunday Eucharist:

- ⊕ **June 5:** 1 Kings 17:17-24; Gal. 1:11-19; Lk. 7:11-17.
- ⊕ **June 12:** 2 Sam. 1 12: 7-10; Gal. 2:16, 19-21; Lk. 7:36-8:3.
- ⊕ **June 19:** Zech. 12:10-11, 13:1; Gal. 3:26-29; Luke 9:18-24.

- ⊕ **June 26:** 1 Kings 19:16b, 19-21; Gal. 5:1,13-18; Lk. 9:51-62.

**FATHER'S DAY:** As is our custom, we will mark this day at the Sunday liturgy on 19 June 2016 with a special blessing at the end of Mass for all fathers, grandfathers, step-fathers, and godfathers.

**ABBEY RETREAT:** The monks of Saint Mary's Abbey will gather for their annual retreat 19-21 June 2016. The retreat will be directed by Fr. Dan Horan, O.F.M. friar of the Holy Name Province (NY). He's a columnist for *America* magazine and author of several books and numerous articles. This is an important opportunity for renewal within the monastic community. *Oremus pro invicem!*

**JUNE SAINT:** St. Barnabas, the New Testament tells us, was a Jew from Cyprus named Joseph. He was

so generous and faith-filled that the apostles gave him the sobriquet *Barnabas*, meaning son of encouragement. Barnabas was responsible for introducing Paul to the other apostles. Paul and Barnabas were sent by the apostles to Antioch, to the community of Gentile converts. Regrettably the pair had a row and parted. Barnabas returned to his native Cyprus to preach the gospel. Paul even makes mention of Barnabas in his letters to the Galatians and Corinthians. He is believed to be a cousin of the evangelist Mark. Tradition claims Barnabas was martyred in the year 61 at Salamis, Cyprus.

The Barnabites (Clerics Regular of St. Paul) are so named as their founder, St. Anthony Maria Zaccaria, established them in Milan in 1530 at the Church of St. Barnabas. The Barnabites devote themselves to preaching inspired by the letters of St. Paul. We need saints like Barnabas who encourage us focus our lives on Christ.



**DIACONATE ORDINATION:** On May 17<sup>th</sup>, Brs. Joseph Voltaggio and Demetrius Thomas were ordained deacons at the Abbey by Bishop Arthur Serratelli, Bishop of Paterson. They will be continuing studies in the fall at Seton Hall University and engage in pastoral and liturgical ministries over the next year. Please congratulate Brs. Joseph and Demetrius, and pray for vocations to the abbey!
