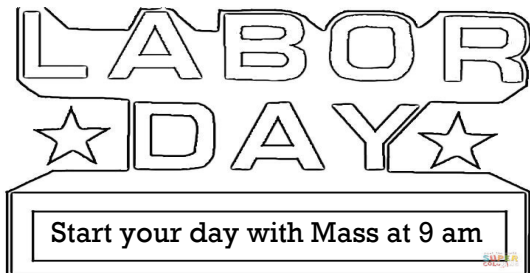

SUNDAY MASS - GO PREPARED!

Here's a good way that you can prepare yourself for Sunday Mass. It is very easy to use our Parish subscription to FORMED.ORG (code TFWVVK) to explore the series called "Opening the Word". For each week, there is a short 5-7 minute video that provides some insight into the Sunday Gospel reading. There is also a Study Guide that can be printed. This Guide uses the Lectio Divina formula of prayer, discussion questions, and resolution, to meditate more deeply on the Scriptural message for that Sunday. The Guide then continues this meditation through each day of the coming week.
