## FRIENDLY FINANCES

Holy Rosary Capital Campaign Update:

We recently made our first interest payment for the construction loan in the amount of \$2,250. We have been collecting pledges on our project for two years now and we are currently at 61% of our goal. We have collected \$1,583,058 of our \$2,620,827 goal. We will receive another disbursement from the Archdiocese at the end of July. Thank you for your continued support!

Saint Patrick Capital Campaign Update:

We currently have 56% of our capital campaign goal! We have collected \$54,918 of our \$97,985 goal. The money that was received from the Archdiocese from this campaign was used to pay for the new boiler. We currently still have three windows available – two half windows and two whole windows. Half windows are \$6,000 and whole windows are \$12,000. We currently need around \$14,000 for the window project to be paid for so thank you for your continued support of St. Patrick!

The meeting was called to order and opened with a prayer led by Kent Schlegel. Linda Lunz made a motion to accept the minutes of February 13, 2017, and Chris Knatz seconded it.

### Updates to the church

The bells are working, but a few repairs still need to be done. Alan Steinke is working on the repairs.

The refurbished ceiling light project should be completed in 2-3 weeks. We are waiting on glass panels to be made for the lights.

Kent Schlegel reported the pole in the parking lot cannot be removed by Midwest. It was noted the night light on the pole on the southeast corner is not working. Midwest will be contacted.

New lights on the front of the church have been installed.

### Financial Report

The finances of the parish are in good standing. A down payment in the amount of \$23,905 has been made towards the window project which could start in May. We still need approximately \$15,000 to meet our goal of \$129,950. There are still two full and two ½ windows available.

### Pastor report

First Communion went well with over 300 people attending the Mass.

The Merciful Love Retreat held at Holy Rosary was attended by 50-60 people.

Father stated he will be here every weekend for Mass for the rest of the year.

There are still 15 seats on the bus to attend Alex Witt's ordination on May 20<sup>th</sup>. Alex will have his first Mass at Holy Rosary, May 21, at 11:00am. A cookie and punch reception will be held after Mass. All St. Patrick parishioners are invited to attend and congratulate Alex. The parish will be giving Alex a monetary gift for the purchase of vestments.

Seminarian Ambrose Dobrozsi will be leaving at the end of May.

There will be a garage sale at Holy Rosary on June 1, 2 and 3. Please check the bulletin for details if you would like to donate any items.

Volunteer slots for Donut Sunday have been filled for 2017.

### New Business

New locks will be installed on two of the rectory doors by Dave Steinke.

2017 Turkey Party will be held at Easy Campground Hall. A new name for the party was suggested.

Pastoral Council would like a report from the Religious Educators at the beginning, middle and end of the teaching year to help keep council informed of the different events and activities planned. The report can be given in person at the PC meeting or in writing.
